

## **Bridge Neighbourhood Plan - Decision Statement (Regulation 18)**

The examiner's report on the Bridge Neighbourhood Plan 2022-2037 was received on 17 November 2023.

This recommended that the Plan should proceed to referendum subject to a number of proposed modifications.

The modifications are required to ensure that the Plan meets the basic conditions set out in legislation. The examiner also recommended that the area for the referendum should be based on the designated neighbourhood area which the Plan relates to.

In accordance with Regulation 18 of the Neighbourhood Planning (General) Regulations 2012, each of the proposed modifications have been accepted by the city council and the Plan will now proceed to referendum.
