We provide pre-planning advice, development management, planning enforcement, planning policy and heritage and local land charges service for the district of Canterbury.

Processing activity

The purposes for which your data will be used:

- Alerting you to planning applications in your area

Lawful bases

Our lawful bases for processing your personal information are:

- Carrying out of a contract to which you are a party (pre planning advice)
- Public task (in relation to our statutory duties)
- Legal Obligation (in relation to our statutory duties)
- Consent (joining our mailing list for consultations)
- Substantial Public Interest (relating to special category data)

Some planning enforcement processing may qualify as law enforcement processing under:

• Data Protection Act 2018 Part 3 Section 35(2)(b) and Schedule 8(1)

Your rights
