Referendum on the adoption of the Bridge Neighbourhood Plan

1. A referendum will be held on Thursday, 28th March 2024 to decide on the question below:

"Do you want Canterbury City Council to use the Neighbourhood Plan for Bridge to help it decide planning applications in the neighbourhood area?"

4. Applications for a Voter Authority Certificate or an Anonymous Elector's Document valid for this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer by 5pm on Wednesday 20 March 2024. Applications can be made online: <https://www.gov.uk/apply-for-photo-id-voter-authority-certificate>
5. New applications to vote by proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Council Offices, Military Road, Canterbury, Kent, CT1 1YW by 5pm on Wednesday, 20th March 2024. <https://www.gov.uk/how-to-vote/voting-by-proxy>
6. Applications to vote by emergency proxy at this election must reach the Electoral Registration Officer at Council Offices, Military Road, Canterbury, Kent, CT1 1YW by 5pm on Thursday, 28th March 2024
