

Notice is hereby given that Canterbury City Council, in exercise of its powers under sections 32, 35 and 38 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and Schedule 9 to that Act, has made an Order for the regulation of the off-street parking places provided by the Council. The Order is to come into force on 1 April 2018.

The effect of the order, the charges which will apply and the restrictions which affect the off-street car parks are set out in the Schedule below.

PART A



If any person wishes to question the validity of the order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within six weeks from the date on which the order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
