

## THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (CENTRAL AREA, CANTERBURY) (TRAFFIC REGULATION) (AMENDMENT No 2) ORDER 2019

Notice is hereby given that KENT COUNTY COUNCIL intends to make the above Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3) and 3(2), of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 (the Act), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Paragraph 20 of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The effect of the Order will be as follows:

- To prohibit all vehicles (except permit holders) 10.30 to 16.00 daily and to prohibit all motor vehicles 16.00 to 10.30 daily (except for loading and disabled badge holders)

St Margaret's Street	From the junction with Hawks Lane to the junction with Watling Street
----------------------	---

- To prohibit all motor vehicles at all times

Hawks Lane	From the junction with St Margaret's Street for a distance of 4 metres in a north-westerly direction
St Peter's Lane	From the junction with St Peter's Street for a distance of 9 metres in a north-easterly direction

- The current one way traffic order that applies to St Peter's Lane will be removed.
- The current one way traffic order that applies to Hawks Lane will be removed.

Full details are contained in the draft order which, together with a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the order, a map showing the location and effect and a copy of any orders which will be amended by the proposed order, may be examined at the Canterbury City Council Offices in Military Road, Canterbury CT1 1YW between 8.45am and 5pm Mondays to Fridays.
