

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, CITY OF CANTERBURY) (PROHIBITION OF STOPPING ON FOOTWAY OR VERGE) (AMENDMENT NO 1a) ORDER 2021

Notice is hereby given that the KENT COUNTY COUNCIL has made the above Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act:

The effect of the Order is to amend the Kent County Council (Various Roads, City Of Canterbury) (Prohibition Of Stopping On Footway Or Verge) (Consolidation) Order 2019 by introducing new or varying existing parking and waiting restrictions on the following lengths of road in the Canterbury district:

| Name of Road | Length of Road |
|-------------------------|---|
| Canterbury | |
| Headcorn Drive | On both sides between the junctions with Bawden Close and Kemsing Gardens |
| Oaten Hill | On both sides for the entire length |
| Orchard Street | On both sides for the entire length |
| Whitstable | |
| Marine Crescent | On both sides for the entire length of all parts of the road, including all islands and grassed areas |
| Plough Lane | On both sides for the entire length |
| Swalecliffe Court Drive | On both sides for the entire length |

The order was made on 14 April 2021 and came into force on 16 April 2021. Full details are contained in the Order which, together with a statement of the council's reasons for making the Order and a copy of the orders amended by the Order, may be examined online at www.canterbury.gov.uk

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or any of the provisions contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant enabling Act or that any requirement of any such enabling Act or of any regulations made thereunder have not been complied with may within six weeks from the date on which the Order was made make application to the High Court for this purpose.
