

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, CITY OF CANTERBURY) (PROHIBITION OF STOPPING ON FOOTWAY OR VERGE) (AMENDMENT NO 1) ORDER 2021

Notice is hereby given that KENT COUNTY COUNCIL propose to make the above Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The effect of the Order is to amend the Kent County Council (Various Roads, City of Canterbury) (Prohibition of Stopping on Footway or Verge) (Consolidation) Order 2019 by introducing new or varying existing parking and waiting restrictions in the Canterbury district:

Ambleside Close	On both sides for the entire length
Headcorn Drive	On both sides between the junctions with Bawden Close and Kemsing Gardens
Oaten Hill	On both sides for the entire length
Orchard Street	On both sides for the entire length
River Bend Close	On both sides for 15 metres from the junction with Westwood Drive
River Dance Drive	On both sides for 21 metres from the junction with Stonebridge Road
Stonebridge Road	On both sides for the entire length
Warwick Road	On both sides for the entire length
Westwood Drive	On both sides for the entire length

Central Avenue	On both sides for the entire length
Pier Avenue	On both sides for the entire length
Whitstable	
Baliol Road	On both sides for the entire length
Marine Crescent	On both sides for the entire length of all parts of the road, including all islands and grassed areas
Plough Lane	On both sides for the entire length
Swalecliffe Court Drive	On both sides for the entire length

Mill Road	On the north western side from the north eastern boundary of 1 Mill Road for 280 metres in a south westerly direction
