

**THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (CANTERBURY) (TRAFFIC REGULATION AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO 3) ORDER 2019**

Notice is hereby given that the KENT COUNTY COUNCIL propose to make the above Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The effect of the Order is to amend The Kent County Council (Canterbury) (Traffic Regulation and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2018 by introducing new or varying existing parking and waiting restrictions on the following lengths of road in Canterbury:

Hever Place & Wichling Close	Double yellow lines at junctions, no parking 9.30 to 10.30am Monday to Friday elsewhere
The Hoystings Close	Permanent removal of parking bays and replacement with double yellow lines
Rose Lane	Conversion of part of the taxi rank to a disabled parking bay
Station Road West	Revised parking layout with two hour/residents' parking bay and disabled parking bay
Wife of Bath Hill	Double yellow lines at the junction with Priest Avenue

**THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (WHITSTABLE) (TRAFFIC REGULATION AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO 3) ORDER 2019**

Notice is hereby given that the KENT COUNTY COUNCIL propose to make the above Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The effect of the Order is to amend The Kent County Council (Whitstable) (Traffic Regulation and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2018 by introducing new or varying existing parking and waiting restrictions on the following lengths of road in Whitstable:

High Street	Allow disabled badge holders to park in the taxi rank
Millstrood Road	Further extend the double yellow lines between Belmont Road and Grimshill Road
Primrose Way	Double yellow lines at the junction between Nos 16 and 26

**THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, CITY OF CANTERBURY) (PROHIBITION OF STOPPING ON FOOTWAY OR VERGE) (AMENDMENT NO 3) ORDER 2019**

Notice is hereby given that the KENT COUNTY COUNCIL propose to make the above Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The effect of the Order is to amend The Kent County Council (Various Roads, City Of Canterbury) (Prohibition Of Stopping On Footway Or Verge) Order 2018 by introducing new or varying existing parking and waiting restrictions on the following lengths of road in Canterbury:

Hever Place	Pavement parking ban
Wichling Close	Pavement parking ban
