

**THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (CANTERBURY) (TRAFFIC REGULATION AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO 1) ORDER 2019**

Notice is hereby given that the KENT COUNTY COUNCIL has made the above Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act:

The effect of the Order is to amend the Kent County Council (Canterbury) (Traffic Regulation and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2018 by introducing new or varying existing parking and waiting restrictions on the following lengths of road in Canterbury:

Alma Street	Extend the existing parking bay outside No 14 and 15 Alma Street.
Beer Cart Lane	Loading ban and goods vehicle loading bay
Davidson Road	Double yellow lines at the entrance to the car park
Lower Chantry Lane	Loading ban between New Dover Road and Edward Road.
Rose Lane	Extend the loading ban to the rising bollard

The effect of the Order is to amend the Kent County Council (Whitstable) (Traffic Regulation and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2018 by introducing new or varying existing parking and waiting restrictions on the following lengths of road in Whitstable:

Cromwell Road	Double yellow lines near No 219
Gorrell Road	Extend the double yellow lines at the junction with Millstrood Road
Joy Lane & Shamrock Avenue	Double yellow lines at the junction
Millstrood Road	Double yellow lines outside No 1a
Old Thanet Way	Weight limit in the lay-by near Chestfield Road
Beach Walk	Bring the charges for on-street pay and display parking into line with the off-street charges
Seymour Avenue	Remove single yellow lines outside Nos 33-35
Thanet Way Service Road (between Reeves Way and Clover Rise)	Double yellow lines

**THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (CANTERBURY RURAL PARISHES) (TRAFFIC REGULATION AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO 1) ORDER 2019**

Notice is hereby given that the KENT COUNTY COUNCIL has made the above Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act:

The effect of the Order is to amend the Kent County Council (Canterbury Rural Parishes) (Traffic Regulation and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2018 by introducing new or varying existing parking and waiting restrictions on the following lengths of road in rural locations in the Canterbury district:

Beech Avenue, Chartham	Double yellow lines opposite the bus stop
Sturry	Increase permit prices in line with inflation
Jubilee Road, Littlebourne	Double yellow lines at the entrance to the recreation ground
School Lane and Chestnut Avenue, Blean	Double yellow lines at the junction

The orders were made on 15 March 2019 and comes into force on 15 March 2019. Full details are contained in the Orders which, together with a statement of the council's reasons for making the Orders and a copy of the orders amended by the Orders, may be examined at the Canterbury City Council offices, Military Road, Canterbury, CT1 1YW during normal office hours.

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or any of the provisions contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant enabling Act or that any requirement of any such enabling Act or of any regulations made thereunder have not been complied with may within six weeks from the date on which the Order was made make application to the High Court for this purpose.
