

Notice is hereby given that the KENT COUNTY COUNCIL has made the above Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act:

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (CANTERBURY) (TRAFFIC REGULATION AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO 2a) ORDER 2021

The effect of the Order is to amend the Kent County Council (Canterbury) (Traffic Regulation and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2019 by introducing new or varying existing parking and waiting restrictions on the following lengths of road in Canterbury:

General	Increase the cost of Visitor Permits in line with other parking charges and inflation
Knight Avenue	Double yellow lines
Priest Avenue	Double yellow lines
Shipman Avenue	Double yellow lines
Wife of Bath Hill	Double yellow lines

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (HERNE BAY) (TRAFFIC REGULATION AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO 2a) ORDER 2021

The effect of the Order is to amend the Kent County Council (Herne Bay) (Traffic Regulation and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2019 by introducing new or varying existing parking and waiting restrictions on the following lengths of road in Herne Bay:

General	Increase the cost of Visitor Permits in line with other parking charges and inflation

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (WHITSTABLE) (TRAFFIC REGULATION AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (AMENDMENT NO 2a) ORDER 2021

The effect of the Order is to amend the Kent County Council (Whitstable) (Traffic Regulation and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2019 by introducing new or varying existing parking and waiting restrictions on the following lengths of road in Whitstable:

Valkyrie Avenue and Sandpiper Road	Make the single yellow line between Grimthorpe Avenue and Sandpiper Road apply seven days a week to prevent parking of large vehicles. Double yellow lines at the junction of Valkyrie Avenue and Sandpiper Road
General	Increase the cost of Visitor Permits in line with other parking charges and inflation

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, CITY OF CANTERBURY) (PROHIBITION OF STOPPING ON FOOTWAY OR VERGE) (AMENDMENT NO 2a) ORDER 2021

The effect of the Order is to amend the Kent County Council (Various Roads, City Of Canterbury) (Prohibition Of Stopping On Footway Or Verge) (Consolidation) Order 2019 by introducing new pavement and verge parking bans on the following lengths of road in the Canterbury District:

Warwick Road, Canterbury	On both sides between the junctions with Littlebourne Road and Kent Avenue
Higgate Road, Whitstable	On both sides for the entire length
Mill Road, Sturry	On the north western side from the north eastern boundary of I Mill Road for 280 metres in a south westerly direction

The orders were made and came into force on 12 October 2021. Full details are contained in the Orders which, together with a statement of the council's reasons for making the Orders and a copy of the orders amended by the Orders, may be examined online at www.canterbury.gov.uk

Any person wishing to question the validity of the Orders or any of the provisions contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers of the relevant enabling Act or that any requirement of any such enabling Act or of any regulations made thereunder have not been complied with may within six weeks from the date on which the Orders was made make application to the High Court for this purpose.
