## **Town and Country Planning (Development Management Procedure) (England) Order 2015**

### **Notice under Article 15(1) of application for planning permission accompanied by an environmental statement**

#### **Proposed development at Land at Highland Court Farm, Coldharbour Lane, Bridge, CT4 5HN**

I give notice that Quinn Estates Ltd & HICO Group is applying to Canterbury City Council for outline/full (hybrid) planning permission (reference number CA//18/01948/FOS) for mixed use development for leisure, commercial and tourism uses comprising:

- (1) A detailed planning application for a centre for sporting excellence (to include sports pitches, changing rooms, clubhouse and floodlights), business innovation centre, food and drinks hub and leisure hub; with access and associated highways works.
