Statement of Licensing Policy

The Licensing Act 2003 requires that the Licensing Authority (Canterbury City Council) publishes a Statement of Licensing Policy document at least once every five years.

On 20 April 2017 the council adopted the current policy.

We invite comments from anyone and will be consulting directly with a wide range of representative bodies, individuals and responsible authorities in addition to those who must be consulted with in accordance with statute.

The consultation period is until 4pm on 31 August 2021 by which time comments must be submitted.
