

The Canterbury City Council (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 2020



NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that Canterbury City Council, in exercise of its powers under sections 32, 35 and 38 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and Schedule 9 to that Act, has made an Order for the regulation of the off-street parking places provided by the Council. The Order came into force on 1 April 2020.

The effect of the order, the charges which apply and the restrictions which affect the off-street car parks are set out in the Schedule below.

PART A

The Order relates to the following car parks:

Albin's, Beach Street, Beach Walk, Bisson's, Black Griffin Lane, Castle Row, Castle Street, Chapel Street, Cow Lane, Essex Street, Fountain Street, Gladstone Road, Gorrell Tank, Hawks Lane, Holmans Meadow, Keam's Yard, Longport, Market Street, Maynard Road, Memorial Park Herne Bay, Middle Wall, Millers Field, Neptune, New Dover Road Park and Ride, New Street, Northgate, North Lane, Notley Street Oyster, Parham Close, Pound Lane, Pound Lane Residents Car Park, Queningate, Reculver Towers, Reculver Country Park, Regent Street, Rosemary Lane, Rye's, Salt Marsh Lane, St James' Gardens, St John's Lane, St Peter's Grove, St Radigund's, School Lane, Simmonds Road, Shaftesbury Road, Southern Way, Station Road West, Sturry Road Park and Ride, Swalecliffe Avenue, Sydenham Street, Tankerton Road, Tower Way, Toddlers Cove, Victoria Recreation Ground, Victoria Street, Watling Street, Whitefriars, Whitstable Harbour, William Street, Wincheap Park and Ride, and Canterbury Coach Park.

If any person wishes to question the validity of the order or of any of its provisions on the grounds that it or they are not within the powers conferred by the Act, or that any requirement of the Act or of any instrument made under the Act has not been complied with, that person may, within six weeks from the date on which the order is made, apply for the purpose to the High Court.
