

THE KENT COUNTY COUNCIL (VARIOUS ROADS, DISTRICT OF CANTERBURY) (WAITING RESTRICTIONS AND STREET PARKING PLACES) (CONSOLIDATION) ORDER 2023 (AMENDMENT NO 11) ORDER 2025

Notice is hereby given that KENT COUNTY COUNCIL propose to make the above Order under sections 1(1), 2(1) to (3), 3(2), 4(1) and (2), 32(1), 35(1), 45, 46, 49 and 53 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act.

The effect of the Order is to amend the Kent County Council (Various Roads, District of Canterbury) (Waiting Restrictions and Street Parking Places) (Consolidation) Order 2023 by introducing new or varying existing parking and waiting restrictions on the following lengths of road in the Canterbury district:

Canterbury

Starle Close	Transfer Starle Close from the All Saints residents' parking zone to the St Gregory's zone
Longport	Change one on-street parking bay to a bay reserved for car club vehicles.
Kemsing Gardens	New yellow lines in Kemsing Gardens
Ashford Road	Extend double yellow lines at the entrance to the Community Hall

Herne Bay

Central Parade	Prohibit returning within four hours in electric vehicle parking bay
