This cemetery is dedicated to the peaceful rest and sanctity of those who have been buried here and provides a tranquil and beautiful environment for those who visit. Please cooperate and follow these regulations:

- Access – all vehicles subject to one way system, except those belonging to staff and contractors.
- Pedestrians and vehicle access available 24 hours daily.
- No dogs are allowed in the grounds, except registered assistance dogs.
- No cycling – please dismount and push your bicycle.
- Children under 12 years or under must be accompanied by an adult or restricted to the public footpath only.
- Interments and strewing of cremated remains only by appointment with cemetery officers.
- Stay away from opened graves and work in progress.
- Avoid the use of plastic flowers, non-biodegradable tributes and cellophane wrappings.
- Use the litter bins provided or dispose of your litter at home.
- Seasonal tributes will be removed four weeks after the festival.
- Anti-social behaviour and disrespect will not be tolerated and will be immediately reported to the Police. Visitors are asked to report such incidents.
- Faded or dead tributes will be removed.
