- Stay away from opened graves and work in except those belonging to staff and contractors. progress. Avoid the use of plastic flowers, nonbiodegradable tributes and cellophane daily. wrappings. registered assistance dogs. Use the litter bins provided or dispose of your litter at home. Seasonal tributes will be removed four weeks bicycle. after the festival.
- Access all vehicles subject to one way system, Pedestrians and vehicle access available 24 hours No dogs are allowed in the grounds, except No cycling – please dismount and push your Children under 12 years or under must be
- accompanied by an adult or restricted to the public footpath only.

Interments and strewing of cremated remains only by appointment with cemetery officers.
